GLENNS' SCHOOL OF DANCE END OF THE YEAR INFORMATION

We look forward to sharing the excitement of "show week" with all of you, and thank you for allowing us to be a part of your "dance journey" this year. We wish you a wonderful summer and look forward to working with you in the future. This packet contains all end of the year info - refer to this packet, speak with our receptionist or email the studio with any questions.

SHOW PROCEDURES: All dancers should be dropped off at the drama room 15 minutes ahead of show time - they will then be directed to their specific dressing area by our volunteer staff. Only the staff is allowed to remain backstage – to ensure a calm, peaceful and safe experience for our young performers. Please take your child to the bathroom before dropping them off, and make sure they have all of their show items with them. We will have an army of caring, capable staff to take care of all of their needs. No food or beverages, except bottled water with a cap, are allowed with the performers.

MEMORIAL DAY BREAK: The studio will be closed Saturday, May 24th– Monday, May 26th in observance of the Memorial Holiday Weekend. Our FINAL week of classes runs from Tuesday, 5/27 up through and including Monday, 6/2. After that, we will be in the theater as Rehearsals and Shows begin on Tuesday, June 3rd.

TUITION: All balances must be paid in full to be eligible to participate in the June Show. If you have a credit, it may be applied to ticket purchases - all credits are on file with the studio.

TICKET SALES, Saturday, May 10th at the studio: Tickets go on sale at 2:00pm for volunteers, 2:30 for all others and will close at 4:00pm. After that, tickets will be available at the studio during our regular reception hours through June 2nd, as well as at the theater during the dress rehearsals, and at the box office on show nights one hour ahead of showtime. Tickets are \$19 credit or \$18 cash/check each - main floor is reserved seating, lecture area seats are at your selection **A volunteer sign up sheet will be available mid-April - we could use your help backstage if you are interested!

COSTUME WEEK: Monday, 4/21 through Thursday, 4/24, we will pass out costumes to students in our Continuing and Children's Levels, whose balances are complete. **Parents of those dancers should attend this week of lessons as all final details will be reviewed** – dress rehearsal times & procedures, final recital information, & information explaining hair & makeup expectations.

All students in our Middle School, High School, and Specialty Group Levels who are up-to-date with tuition & costume payments, will receive costumes in class the week of Monday, 4/14 through Thursday, 4/17. Final instructions for those students will be given in those classes. Parents of these older dancers do not need to come in, as the kids are self-sufficient and/or seasoned at this point!

SOUVENIR SHOW SHIRTS!!!: A great good luck gift for your dancer, and parents look great in them too! Forms for preorders will be available following Spring Break - deadline and all info will be available on the Order Form. We will have a minimal amount of extras in case you miss the pre-order, but when they're gone, they're gone! Get 'em while they're hot!

ADDITIONAL DRESS REHEARSAL INFORMATION: Dress Rehearsals are closed to the public – open only to the students and their families – all siblings must be supervised. Pictures (PLEASE NO FLASHES while the dancers are dancing) & videotaping are allowed at Dress Rehearsal ONLY – we respectfully request that you leave all cameras at home for the shows, as filming & photographing during the performances is prohibited.

A professional photographer will be taking individual photos at the Dress Rehearsals for those interested, & the shows will be professionally taped, giving you the opportunity to purchase a reproduction of the show - order forms for photos & videos will be available at the Dress Rehearsals.

These companies are separate from Glenns' - please direct all questions to them.

2025-2026 School Year Season

We would love to share our next school year with you! Please look over the following options for our 2025-2026 season. Mid-July, all necessary registration information will be published on our website - a Facebook announcement will be made when that registration is up and running - many classes sell out quickly, so connect with us on Facebook to get that initial announcement. That announcement will help you navigate all necessary information and procedures on our website! Those dancers that are accepted into our Specialty Group programs will receive a more detailed registration packet by email after the 4th of July holiday.

PROGRAMS FOR FALL

We have 3 Options for enrollment as we have three distinct programs available to best serve you:

OPTION #1 – The Children's and Recreational Program: for our young dancers and dancers that wish to take their classes "a la carte". In July, when our Fall Registration is up and running, the schedule will be available for you to view and select age/experience appropriate classes based on the styles of dance in which you are interested. You will register directly on line, listing the classes you are selecting and our office will get back to you with a confirmation email within 48 business hours.

OPTION #2 - The Petite Preparatory/Apprentice/Competition Program: if you wish to take your dancing to a more intense level. These dancers perform in an additional show in the spring, and are invited to attend dance conventions & our guest artist series – these dancers also perform in an additional competition in the spring. Dancers admitted into this program should be currently studying ballet, jazz, and lyrical, entering 3rd grade or older - if you are hoping to be placed in this program for the first time, or if you would like to be placed in a subset company of mini, intermediate, or advanced for the first time, you must also study during our 2-week summer dance intensive. If you are placed in this program, you will train in one of four levels within this program based on age, and will study ballet, jazz, and lyrical with the other members of your level. If you are selected, you will receive a detailed registration packet by email after the 4th of July holiday. In that email packet, you will also be given times for optional classes in tap, musical theater and hiphop. After receiving that email, complete our online registration to confirm your classes, and our office will get back to you with a confirmation email.

*As educators, we spend all year evaluating each child's strengths, to place each student in a level that will inspire and challenge them, without overwhelming them – we place you at a level that will allow for your success. If this level is not the best fit for you at this time, you are welcome to request feedback from your instructors as to the best path to take your dancing to make this a good fit for you in the future.

OPTION #3 - Performing Arts Dance Theater – our children's company-in-residence:Entrance into this program is through an audition held in early summer. Information regarding the company and its audition is currently available on the website. All PADT dancers will receive an email from our office in July when our registration is up and running – enrollment procedures will be included in this email.

OUR 2 WEEK A LA CARTE PROGRAM

OUR 2 WEEK PRE-APPRENTICE PROGRAM

This is a mandatory program for those seeking entrance for the first time in our Apprentice or Petite Preparatory programs for the 25-26 School Year Season. Check out the info under the "Summer Programs" tab for the program designed just for you! Print and fill out the enrollment form and bring in person or mail to the studio with payment.

OUR 2 WEEK SUMMER DANCE INTENSIVE

Current Petite Prep/Apprentice, and Advanced Middle & High School

This program is set up to give intense training to our advanced dancers. For more information, check out the Summer Intensive Information & Enrollment packet currently available under our "Summer Programs" tab on the website. Print and fill out the enrollment form and bring in person or mail to the studio with payment. To best ensure a spot in your desired level, enroll by June 4th. Walk-ins will be taken based on availability.

*This program is required for the Dancers in PADT. It is required for those hoping to gain entrance into our competition/apprentice/petite prep programs or their subsets (Mini, Intermediate, Advanced Cos) for the first time. It is highly recommended for dancers currently enrolled in our specialty groups and their subsets.
